INFORMATION ABOUT NF's RANKING AND WORLD CUP QUOTAS ATTRIBUTION FROM ICF RANKING

1. All currently affiliated member Federations of the ICF will get a minimum allocation of one (1) boat per event in the CSL World Cup. Up to four (4) additional quotas may be qualified through the 2009 ICF CSL Rankings.
2. To fulfill the Article 44.3.1 of the Canoe Slalom Rules, the ICF Canoe Slalom Committee has established a ranking of the Federations for each event from the 2009 ICF CSL Ranking.
3. For 2010 an official **C1 Women** World Cup series will be held and, as a developing class, will be limited to 3 boats per Federation for the 2010 World Cup season.
4. The ranking for the Federations in all other events (K1M, K1W, C1M and C2M) is established as follows:
 - K1M, K1W, C1M and C2 competitors with 50 or less ranking points are considered when developing the Nation ranking.
 - Additional quota (1+1) allocation based on a Federation having two competitors in the 2009 ICF ranking with 50 or less ranking points.
 - Additional quota (1+2) allocation based on a Federation having three competitors in the 2009 ICF ranking with 50 or less ranking points.
 - Additional quota (1+3) allocation based on a Federation having four competitors in the 2009 ICF ranking with 50 or less ranking points. This quota allocation is open to the Federations ranked 3rd to 5th in K1M, and 2nd or 3rd in K1W, C1M and C2 events.

- Additional quota (1+4) allocation based on a Federation having five or more competitors in the 2009 ICF ranking with 50 or less ranking points. This quota allocation (1+4) is open to the top two ranked Federations in K1M, and the top ranked Federation in K1W, C1M and C2M.

However the ICF CSL Canoe Slalom Committee have decided to attribute 1 (one) “invitational” additional quota for a Federation fulfilling criteria as below:

- Federation having only one boat ranked within the 50 ranking point limit but belonging to the ICF Development and Talent identification programme.
- Federation in development having a second boat ranked with 60 or less ranking points.

The ICF CSL Canoe Slalom Committee have also extended a special invitation to NED (K1W) based on the ranking the second NED K1W and SRB (C1), RSA (C1) based on the aim to increase participation in this event.

Example for K1 MEN

From the 2009 ICF ranking (4th release) we calculate the first Federation who has five (5) boats ranked in the highest position, they receive the Nation rank position N°1, the second Federation who has five (5) boats ranked is second. For the 3rd to 5th place we rank the next two Federations with four (4) boats in the ranking list. For position 6th to 25th we rank the next Federations with (3) boats in the ranking list. Finally we rank Federations with two (2) boats in the list with 50 or less ranking points.
